Subject: Critical Energy Infrastructure Information ("CEII") - Third Workshop

Dear Participants:

On November 29, 2010, Board staff held a second workshop to discuss the identification, protection, and handling of CEII. During the workshop, the CEII-WG discussed information circulated by VELCO and various CEII-related issues including definitions, scope, protections, and procedures.

The CEII-WG agreed to participate in a third CEII workshop. Board staff intend to conduct the third CEII workshop on **Thursday, February 17, 2011, commencing at 1:30 P.M.**, at the Public Service Board Hearing Room, Third Floor, Chittenden Bank Building, 112 State Street, Montpelier, Vermont.

VELCO, the Department, and CVPS agreed to circulate the following documents, via email and/or CD, to the CEII-WG by **January 18, 2011**:

- VELCO: (a) VELCO's internal CEII policy documents; (b) a hypothetical CEII filing based on the docket filings for a previous project, such as Tafts Corners; (c) draft averments based on the hypothetical CEII filing;¹ and (d) a revised CEII-specific, draft Protective Order which governs the production of materials and discovery;
- Department: a draft protective agreement; and
- CVPS: CVPS's draft CEII policy documents.

As discussed, please review the CEII-related filings in Docket 370 on the Connecticut Siting Council's website at <http://www.ct.gov/csc/cwp/view.asp?a=962&Q=425498&PM=1>.² In addition, the CEII-WG agreed to review previous protective orders issued by the Board, which have addressed proposals to include confidential information in the evidentiary record. I plan to distribute a final agenda for the February 17 workshop and any additional information by **February 10, 2011**.
