Re: Appointments to VSPC Electric Supply Representative Position

Date: April 9, 2014

In a November 8, 2013, Order in Docket 8073, the Vermont Public Service Board ("Board") approved an amendment to the memorandum of understanding governing the Vermont System Planning Committee ("VSPC") which created an additional position within the Supply and Demand Resources sector to represent the interests of electric supply resources. Subsequent to that Order, the Board advertised the opening for this position and for an alternate member to represent the interests of electric supply resources, and received responses from four individuals.

On March 3, 2014, the Clerk of the Board issued a memorandum inviting comments on the four candidates. Comments were submitted by the Vermont Electric Power Company, Inc. and Vermont Transco LLC, the Vermont Department of Public Service, Green Mountain Power Corporation, and the Vermont Energy Investment Corporation.

The Board has asked me to inform you that, after reviewing the candidates' letters of interest and the written comments, on April 8, 2014, it has appointed Nathaniel Vandal as the member representing electric supply resources and Gabrielle Stebbins as the alternate. Consistent with the other VSPC members appointed by the Board, the above individuals shall serve for a five-year term, or until April 8, 2019.
