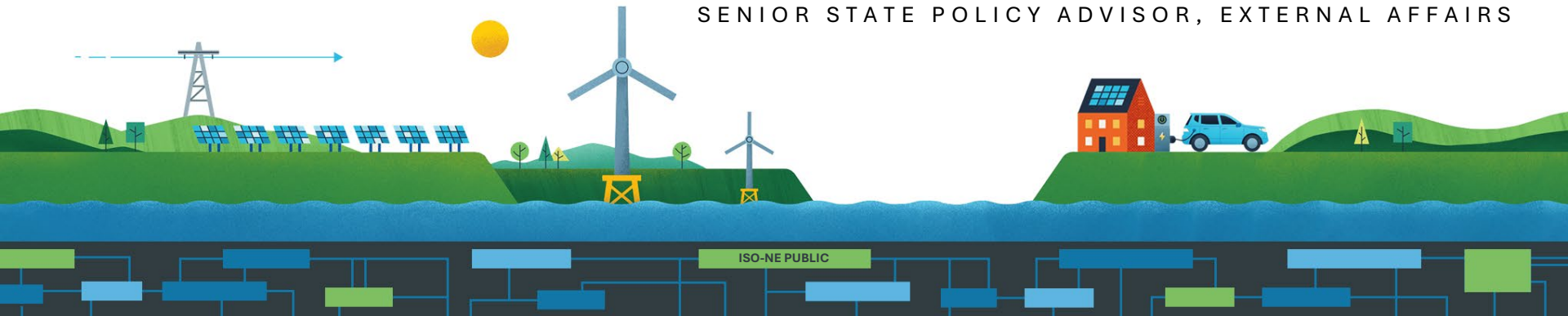

2

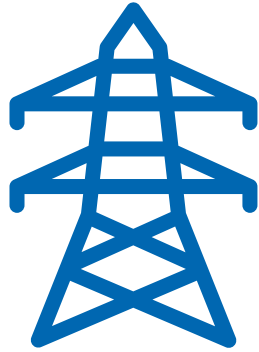
Formal Service application and System Impact Study Agreement
